Dear Participant,

The Dicky Beach Surf Life Saving Club is conducting the annual live-in camp for U14s to qualify for their Surf Rescue Certificates and for current cadet members wishing to qualify for their Bronze Award. Members undertaking their Bronze Award will be issued with a bronze medallion/Certificate II Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue) and Surf Rescue Certificate for Under 14's, upon successful completion of this qualification.

The camp will be conducted from **3pm Sunday 23rd September to 8pm Friday 28th September 2018**, The Presentation will be held on Friday night.

The sleeping arrangements will be the girls using both Dorms and the boys will be sleeping in the Boat Shed. **(Boys will need to bring stretcher or mattress)**

During the day, all valuables will be stored safely away.

(Please DO NOT bring mobile phones or electronic devices, they will be confiscated)

As with all camps of this nature it is important we have parent participation to assist with the running of the camp. Parents are asked to:

- Provide either a morning tea or afternoon tea once during the course of the camp; and
- Assist one day with the preparation of the food, between the hours of 6.30am and 8pm approximately,

REMEMBER: All the trainers & assessors and leaders are volunteers too. They give up a week of their annual leave to train the children. So please help where you can.

All Pool swims for camp participants must be completed at one of the Club sign-on days:
John Wallace Pool, Caloundra **26th August 9am-12pm and 1st September 2pm-4pm.**

For catering purposes the attached forms must be forwarded to the Club Administrator, no later than **14th September 2018.**

Payments must be made via Members Portal account or direct to the office.

Should you have any difficulty in paying for the camp; arrangements can be made to make part payments. The 2018/2019 membership fees must also be paid by commencement of the camp.

LUI Number for Bronze Candidates only

The bronze medallion (Certificate II in Public Safety Aquatic Rescue) will give students 4 points to bank towards their Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE). Students who are interested in gaining these points need to obtain their LUI number from their school and complete a VET form on the last day of camp. The form cannot be submitted without a LUI number.

USI Number for Bronze Candidates only

All students who undertake training for a nationally recognised VET qualification (such as a bronze medallion) must have a Unique Student Identifier (USI). If you have not yet obtained a USI you can apply for it directly at <http://www.usi.gov.au/create-your-USI/> on a computer or mobile device.
